INVITATION NOTICE FOR SUBMISSION OF OFFERS FOR PURCHASE OF PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT – PPE DESIGNATED FOR BHMAC

1. Publication reference:

The Procurement of 50 sets of Personal Protective Equipment – PPE (protective vests and protective visors) Designated for Mine Action Centre of Bosnia and Herzegovina – BHMAC

2. Procedure:

Participation is open on equal terms for private business entities (companies)

3. Contracting Authority:

ITF Enhancing Human Security (ITF)

4. Description of the Procurement of Equipment:

5. Eligibility and rules of origin

Participation is open on equal terms for private business entities (companies).

Tenderer shall not be considered eligible if: (Ethics Clauses)

1. Tenderer is bankrupt, are having their affairs administered by the courts, have entered into an arrangement with creditors, have suspended business activities or are in any analogous situation arising from a similar procedure provided for in national legislation or regulations;
2. They are the subject of proceedings for a declaration of bankruptcy, for administration by the courts, for an arrangement with creditors or for any similar procedure provided for in national legislation or regulations;
3. They have been convicted of an offence concerning professional conduct by a judgment, which has the force of res judicata;
4. They have been convicted by final judgment of participating in a criminal organization, corruption, fraud or money laundering;
5. They are guilty of professional misconduct proven by any means, which the Contracting Authority can justify;
6. They have not fulfilled obligations relating to the payment of social security contributions in accordance with the legal provisions of the country where they are established; or have not fulfilled obligations relating to the payment of taxes in accordance with the legal provisions of the country where they are established;
7. They are guilty of serious misrepresentation in the supplying of the information required by the Contracting Authority as a condition of participation in the Invitation notice for submission of offers procedure.
8. They have been declared to be in serious breach of Contract for failure to comply with obligations in connection with another Contract with the same Contracting Authority or another Contract financed by community funds.

6. General terms

- The currency of donation is the United States Dollars (USD), therefore prices of the offers should be expressed in USD and should not include VAT.

- The Mine Action Centre of Bosnia and Herzegovina – BHMAC is acting as the recipient in this Invitation notice for submission of offers, therefore the offer should include delivery/transportation of 50 sets of PPE to the address Ul. Tvornička 3, 71000 Sarajevo”.
- The Contracting Authority reserves the right to do the final selection based on the funds available for the procurement.
- Tenderer in offered technical specification must indicate guaranty deadline.
- The Tender and all correspondence and documents related to the Tender exchanged by the Tenderer and the Contracting Authority shall be written in English, which is the language of procedure for this tender. Also, all correspondence for payments including pro-forma invoice invoices, and final payment certificates shall be sent to the Contracting Authority in English or local language with English translation.
- This Invitation notice for submission of offers is governed by the laws of the Republic of Slovenia.
- Tenderer shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of his Offer. In no case the Contracting Authority will be responsible or liable for such costs, regardless of the process or results of the Invitation notice for submission of offers procedure.
- In case the Tenderer acts as a party in a joint venture or a consortium of tenderers, the contract shall be enclosed (i.e. a Partnership Agreement) stipulating how the public contract awarded within this procurement procedure will be executed, specifying, in particular, the leading partner authorized to assume from the Contracting Authority obligations, instructions, and possibly payments on behalf of and for the account of all the partners, and the share and type of services to be performed by each individual partner. The Agreement shall clearly stipulate that in relation to the Contracting Authority, all the partners are jointly and severally liable for the entire obligation and each part of it.

7. Sealing and marking of Offers

The original of the offer shall be typewritten or written in indelible ink and signed by a person or persons authorized to sign on behalf of the Tenderer using the Form of Tender provided in Annex II.

Tenderer shall seal the offer in an envelope or package. Please, clearly mark the envelope as follows:

“The Procurement of PP Equipment.”

“Not to be opened before the Offers opening session.”

If the outer envelope is not sealed and marked as required, the Contracting Authority will assume no responsibility for the misplacement or premature opening of the Offer.

8. Evaluation of proposals

Acceptable offers will be evaluated by the Contracting Authority applying the criteria off technically the most suitable equipment and the lowest price. Only the Tenderer of the winning offer will be informed in written form. The tenderer will be asked to provide a sample to inspect prior to final decision.

9. Appeal procedure

Un-successful tenderer can complain to the decision of the Evaluation commission in writing in 7 calendar days after receipt of the notification on unsuccessful tender and until the deadline written in the notification. The Appeal has to be addressed to the chairperson of the Evaluation commission and has to be sent with registered mail or be delivered personally. The confirmation of payment in amount of 400 EUR or equivalent in local currency has to be enclosed to the Appeal. The payment has to be made on the ITF account - IBAN: SI56 30000-0006276227, BIC: SABRSI2X, Sberbank Bank d.d., Dunajska cesta 128/A, 1000 Ljubljana, Slovenia. In the case of justified Appeal, the amount will be returned to the tenderer. The chairperson, if the Appeal was sent in the prescribed deadline and if the

confirmation of the payment is enclosed, sends the answer on the Appeal latest in 7 calendar days after the receipt of the Appeal.

After 5 years of use, the protective vest will be retested in order to check for previously given characteristics. Declaration of manufacture, date of manufacture or a retest, and serial number and quality, should be sewn onto the inside of the cover material and onto each individual part of the protective material (Kevlar, Twaron etc).
