**3. Contracting Authority:**

**4. Description of the contracts:**

- 4.1. Preliminary Risk Assessment (historical research)
- 4.2. Battle Area Clearance (BAC) of abandoned storage entrance and surrounding areas
- 4.3. Tunnel Investigation (confirm or refute the presence of the ERW within abandoned storage / tunnel and define its original structure)
- 4.4. Detailed Risk Assessment

**5. Eligibility and rules of origin**

Participation is open on equal terms as described to commercial companies and non-governmental organizations, international and national, which are registered to perform related activities and possess licence(s) and all other relevant permissions to perform the required activities, issued by the relevant national bodies, and as per Donor's specific decision.

The company or organization shall provide relevant evidence of the past experience (performed projects and contracts) over the past 3 years at minimum - supported by the document(s) / confirmation(s) by relevant institution(s) / organization(s) (reference confirmation(s)) – signed and stamped.

The company/organization is obliged to register and obtain DUNS number at <https://iupdate.dnb.com/iUpdate/mainlaunchpage.htm> before applying for this tender.

The company's principals/officials must not be on the Specially Designated Nationals List (SDN) - <http://www.treasury.gov/ofac/downloads/t11sdn.pdf> - of the U.S. Treasury Office of Foreign Assets Control (OFAC). The tenderer itself is responsible to check the SDN list.

Donor's specific conditions and requirements shall be taken into consideration at all tendering procedures.

## **6. Validity and guarantee**

Offer shall be valid for period of minimum 120 days after the deadline for submission of Offer and must be accompanied by an Offer Guarantee in the amount of 500,00 USD. The guarantee shall be valid for a period up to and including minimum 120 days after the deadline for submission of Offer. This guarantee will be released to unsuccessful Offeror(s) once the procedure has been completed and to the successful Offeror upon signature of the contract by all parties.

## **7. Performance guarantees**

The successful Offeror will be asked to provide a performance guarantee of 10 % of the amount of the contract at the signing of the contract. Performance guarantee shall be valid for a minimum of 180 days after signing of the contract. If the selected Offeror fails to provide such a guarantee within this period, the contract will be void and a new contract may be drawn up and sent to the Offeror, which has submitted the second best admissible Offer.

## **8. Information meeting and/or site visit to inspect the project location**

Site visit to inspect the project location with potential Offerors is mandatory and will be organized, according to schedule / plan of inspection as set within *documentation with instructions for offer preparation - dossier*.

## **9. How to obtain the dossier**
