4. Description of the contract:

Construction of the Plateau based on detailed technical project documentation/project design for Rogami ERW storage (Design of Plateau – Architectural and Structural, including all required segments*), for the upgrade of pyrotechnical safety, physical security and access control for objects for temporary ERW storage Rogami – under the authority of Ministry of Interior - Emergency Management Directorate

(*included in *Documentation with instructions for offer preparation – Dossier*).

The proposal should comprise of the detailed operational technical construction plan and detailed financial offer.

5. Eligibility and rules of origin

Participation is open on equal terms as described to Montenegro licensed construction commercial companies, international and national, which are registered to perform related activities and possess all required licence(s) and all other relevant permissions to perform the required activities, issued by the relevant national bodies, and as per Donor's specific decision.

The company/organization shall have successfully completed as Prime or Sub-Contractor, at least 1 project of the same nature/amount/complexity comparable to the description in point 4 over the last 3 years, supported by the document(s)/confirmation(s) by the relevant institution(s)/organization(s) (reference confirmation(s) – signed and stamped).

The company/organization is obliged to register and obtain UEI – Unique Entity ID at <https://www.gsa.gov/about-us/organization/federal-acquisition-service/office-of-systems-management/integrated-award-environment-iae/iae-systems-information-kit/unique-entity-identifier-update> before applying for this Invitation for submission of offers.

The company's principals/officials must be searched through the System for Award Management – SAM.gov – which may be accessed through the following link <https://www.sam.gov/portal/public/SAM/>. The offeror itself is responsible to check the SAM.gov.

Donor's specific conditions and requirements must be taken into consideration and fulfilled at all related administrative procedures.

6. Validity and guarantee

Offer shall be valid for period of minimum 90 (ninety) days after the deadline for submission of Offer and must be accompanied by an Offer Guarantee in the amount of 1.000,00 USD. The guarantee shall be valid for a period up to and including minimum 90 (ninety) days after the deadline for submission of Offer. This guarantee will be released to unsuccessful Offeror(s) once the procedure has been completed and to the successful Offeror upon signature of the contract by all parties.

7. Performance guarantees

The successful Offeror will be asked to provide a performance guarantee of 10 % of the amount of the contract at the signing of the contract. Performance guarantee shall be valid for a minimum of 120 days after the works completion deadline (based on the date of the contract signing). If the selected Offeror fails to provide such a guarantee within this period, the contract will be void and a new contract may be drawn up and sent to the Offeror, which has submitted the second best admissible Offer.

8. Information meeting and/or site visit to inspect the project location

Site visit to inspect the project location with potential Offerors is mandatory and will be organized, according to schedule/plan of inspection as set within *documentation with instructions for offer preparation - dossier*.

9. How to obtain the dossier

Interested eligible Offeror(s) may purchase the dossier for the project at the ITF Headquarters in Slovenia (please contact Urša Marinšek Šrot at email address Ursa.Marinsek-Srot@itf.si), from **Wednesday, 23 August 2023** from 12:00 hours, and in following days. Offers must be submitted using the prescribed forms included in the dossier, of which format and instructions must be strictly observed.

11. Deadline for submission of offers

The sealed Offers shall be delivered by registered mail or in person, to **ITF Enhancing Human Security, Trg republike 3, 1000 Ljubljana, Slovenia** by **Friday, 06 October 2023 at 12:00 hrs** (local time). Any offer received after this deadline will not be considered.

12. Deadline for completion

All works including inspection, certification and hand-over must be completed at the latest by **30 April 2024**.
